

KCR STATEMENT REGARDING CPDMS and ICD 10 CM COMPLIANCE

The software used by Kentucky hospitals to report cancer cases to the Kentucky Cancer Registry, called the Cancer Patient Data Management System (CPDMS), was updated to be ICD-10 compliant on August 27, 2013. CPDMS includes data items to record secondary diagnoses with ICD-10 codes. The software validates these codes using the ICD-10 CM published listing.

The cancer diagnosis is reported to KCR using the International Classification of Diseases for Oncology, 3rd edition (ICD-O-3). The data items reported using ICD-O-3 codes are topography, morphology, and tumor behavior.

Finally, the identification of cancer diagnoses in a hospital is specified by the Casefinding List. The current Casefinding List in the CPDMS Abstractors Manual includes a link to the SEER web site with ICD-10 CM Casefinding Codes, as well as ICD 9 CM codes, for use whenever a hospital adopts ICD-10 coding (<http://seer.cancer.gov/tools/casefinding/case2015-icd10cm.html>).
